Room in the Inn season ends this week

Christ Church Cathedral announces the upcoming completion of the first season of Room in the Inn (RITI) Louisville, a community ministry providing an overnight safe haven for women and their minor children each night of the week from January 8 through February 28. Seventeen months in the making,

the success of this pilot program paves the way for future expansion and increased impact.

None of this work would have been possible without the hard work and dedication of this Cathedral congregation. Many of you have been in Deans Hall late into the night and early in the morning to make sure our neighbors had a safe and loving space to get out of the cold. And the members of the planning team both laid the groundwork and helped navigate the challenges which came up during the RITI shelter season. And all of you have prayed for God's blessing on this new ministry.

We will soon be announcing more details about an end of the season celebration. We hope that you'll make plans to join with the other congregations and their volunteers as we rejoice over what God has done here in our community at the Cathedral this winter.
