## **Meet Rev. Michael Allemang — Cathedral Sexton**

By now, many of you know Rev. Michael Allemang and his wife, Rebecca. Michael has shared his gifts for street ministry around the Cathedral for some time now. He was raised in the Pentecostal Assemblies of God Church in Zion, Illinois, just outside of Chicago and is a Universalists Interfaith Minister. He has lived in Louisville since 1994 and in Old Louisville for 14 years, and has had many years of experience in serving Louisville's unhoused population, still oftentimes serving people's needs out of the back of his car.

In 2007 he was Baptized and Confirmed at St. Alban's, and later admitted to The School of Ministry in the Diocese of Kentucky. He remains active in service to the unhoused, and that serving and service brought him most recently to Christ Church Cathedral with his wife. Michael was very active in Room In The Inn this past January and February, and continues his outreach to the unhoused with ministries both inside and outside of the Church.

## **Updates on Racing Louisville FC's Tickets, Parking , and T-Shirts for The Pride Game Night on May 29, 8pm**

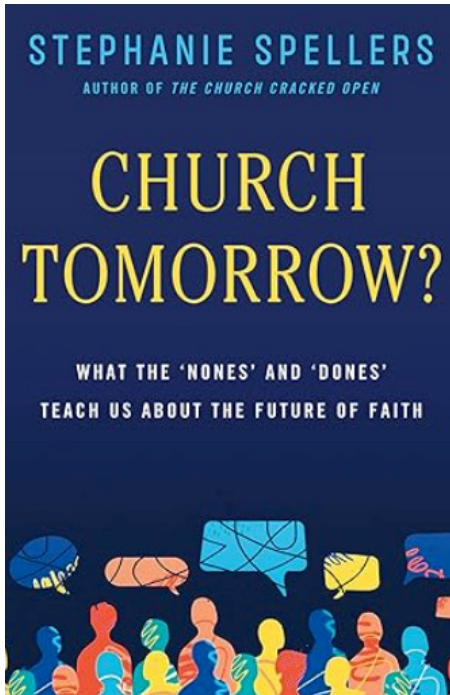
The Ticket Link has arrived! Mark your calendars and select your seats using the Ticket link below! Once again, LGBTQIA+ Affirming Louisville area Churches will gather for an evening outing to watch Racing Louisville Footclub for a Pride Game at Lynn Family Stadium. In Addition to the Ticket Link, there will soon be a link for ordering Pride Night T-Shirts, as we did last year. That link will be posted as soon as it is available to us. The group will have a section of seats held for us, so that all the Church communities are sitting together. You will be able to select seats from within that group section. There is paid parking at the stadium. If being close to the stadium matters, the Gray and Purple lots are the ones to review. Purple is the higher-priced option. I park in Gray myself. It's a really solid middle ground, close enough to be convenient and easy to get in and out after the match. If you're looking to spend less, the Gold lot is the cheapest option, just know that it involves a bit more of a walk and navigating some stairs on the way in.

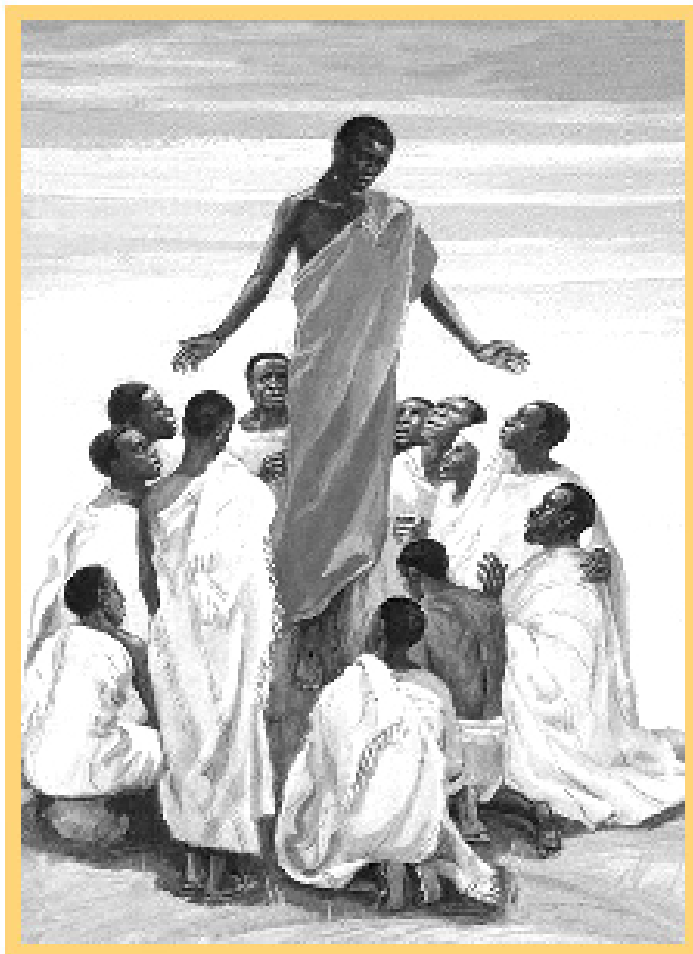
