Dinner Church

On August 27 at 6:30pm, the fourth Thursday of the Month, we will launch our first monthly Dinner Church. Dinner Church was developed out of the Fresh Expressions Movement that originated in the Church of England in the 1990s and became an ecumenical movement in the United States.

Dinner Church allows for a safe place and space for those who are deconstructing their faith, finding their faith again, or seeking faith again for the first time. Dinner Church entails a time of fellowship and food, followed by music, prayer, and engagement with Scripture through a variety of ways. We end with celebrating communion together.

We would love for you to be a part of this new worship offering. First, we need people to sign up to bring something to the potluck dinner. You can sign up for an appetizer, entree, or dessert during coffee hour or on the bulletin board. *The sign up sheet is on a clipboard available in Bishop's Hall during Coffee Hour.* Please note that we are hoping to have five people sign up under each food group category, so that one person doesn't have to feed such a large number of people.
